A huge round of applause to 9C for such a presentable and inspiring session!




Leadership is an Action, Not a Title! ✨


The Big Titles: After some intense and witty Q&A rounds, we finally crowned our Mr. Petrine and Ms. Petrine!




ORIENTATION FOR CLASS 10: PRIORITISING WELL-BEING AND HOLISTIC GROWTH


