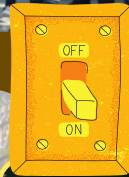
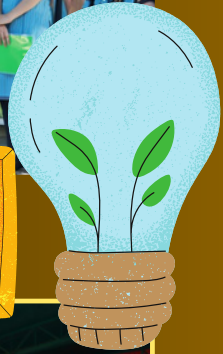
**Rev. Fr. S. Joseph, the Principal of the school, was honoured and awarded with the title of 'Beacon of Hope of the Year 2022'**
